Born in Winnipeg and growing up in Winnipeg's North End, Kevin Chief has considerable public sector and community experience. Before becoming vice-president at the Business Council of Manitoba, Kevin spent six years as a member of the Legislative Assembly in Manitoba, representing Point Douglas. He was appointed Minister of Children and Youth Opportunities in 2012, Minister responsible for the City of Winnipeg in 2013, and Minister of Jobs and the Economy in 2014. He announced his resignation as a member of the legislative assembly at the end of 2016. While serving as a minister, Kevin was a member of Treasury Board and chaired the Healthy Child Committee of Cabinet. Kevin and his wife Melanie have three young sons: Hayden, Kellan, and Daxton. He is also known as a high steppin' square dancer as part of the Norman Chief Memorial Dancers.
